## COVID-19 Antiviral Treatment

## Did your patient test positive for COVID-19?

The Wisconsin Department of Health Services, in partnership with Color, is offering free consultations for providers to determine if COVID-19 treatment is appropriate.

Antiviral treatment is for people with mild to moderate COVID-19 who are **within 5 days of symptom onset**. COVID-19 treatment can help reduce the chance for severe disease and prevent hospitalization.

## Here's how it works:

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**Step 1:** If your need advice on whether COVID-19 treatment should be prescribed to your patient, call the COVID-19 treatment hotline at **833-273-6330**. Services are available 8AM - 8PM daily.



**Step 3:** Connect with a clinician for an online consultation within 5-15 minutes.

**Step 4:** The clinician will provide confidential answers for questions about drug interactions or clinical challenges for your patient. Based on the clinician's answers, **you**, **the provider,** will ultimately decide whether or not to prescribe antivirals to your patient.

**Step 2:** Provide the agent with

your preferred phone number,

your patient's name, your facility,

and the nature of your question.
